Institute of Comparative Law (Serbia), in cooperation with Faculty of Law Osijek (Croatia) and Faculty of Law Pecs (Hungary) has initiated a new international conference, *Regional Law Review*. The conference is devoted to topical legal issues in the region of the Balkans and Southeastern Europe.

The conference offers a forum for scholars to who research current topics in their countries, to foster a discussion on topical issues, achievements and tendencies in the development of legal science and to assert, through a critical review, the position the state of affairs in a particular state or in the entire region relative to European and global standards, with a view to future developments.

Having in mind you that you are an established scholar and professional in your field, we respectfully invite you to contribute to the first regional conference and help us pave the way for its future development.

We aspire for our endeavor to be recognized as a current, relevant and conducive for regional cooperation in the area of legal science.

The conference will consist of two sections: Public Law Section and Private Law Section. Authors are free to choose a specific topic of their interest within one of the two modules.

Important dates:

- Deadline for the paper topic and abstract: April 15, 2020.
- Notice of the acceptance of the research topic: April 25, 2020.
- Deadline for the submission of papers: September 10, 2020.
- Deadline for the review procedure and notification of acceptance of papers for printing: September 20, 2020.
- Conference date: October 8-10, 2020 in Sombor.

Working language of the conference is English.

There is no participation fee for the conference. The costs of accommodation for all participants, as well as meals during the conference, shall be borne by the organisers. The participants shall arrange the transportation themselves. Transportation costs shall not be refunded.

After the paper has been accepted for the conference, the author can choose whether to participate in the conference or have the paper printed without being presented at the conference.

All accepted papers shall be published in late 2020 and first half of 2021 in two issues, as per the appropriate conference module.
